- Created new front access path, with safety barrier, storage & flower beds.
- Bicycle Park built
- Resurface & remark playgrounds

- Raised beds & greenhouse installed for growing area + 'tyre planters' & water storage developed for sustainability
- Trim Trail designed & installed
