SCHOOL HOLIDAY SWIMMING GUIDELINES

JULY/AUGUST 2013

In line with County criteria, only current pupils of Castle Camps Primary School, and siblings who will begin in September 2013, are allowed to use the pool.

All children must be accompanied by an adult who remains on site during the swimming session.

All children must stay within the swimming pool area throughout the session.

- § Entrance to the pool will be through the side gate; there will be no access into the main building.
- § All children will have their name entered in the swimming register book and payment of £1 per child will be collected.
- § Parents must ensure that children with asthma have their inhalers with them.
- § The rules for using the pool are displayed on the changing room wall.
- § The first aid kit and a litter bin are situated in the first changing area.
- § No more than 15 children should use the pool at any one time. Should the number of children who arrive to swim exceed 15, those who arrived first should be asked to leave the pool after 30 minutes. The children of supervisors should be the last to leave, if necessary.
- § No inflatables or flippers, with the exception of swimming aids such as armbands and safety rings, are permitted.
- All children must wear a swimming hat for safety reasons.
- § No jumping or diving from the steps or side of the pool is allowed.
- § Swimmers must not lean out over the edge of the pool; if they fall out the concrete is very hard!
- § Only two balls are allowed in the pool at any one time.
- § Children must not run around the poolside – it gets very slippery.
- § Toilet facilities are available in the Mobile.

In the Event of an Emergency

- § The pool will be cleared by one blast on the whistle.
- § One supervisor will stay with the children while the other adult makes an emergency telephone call.
