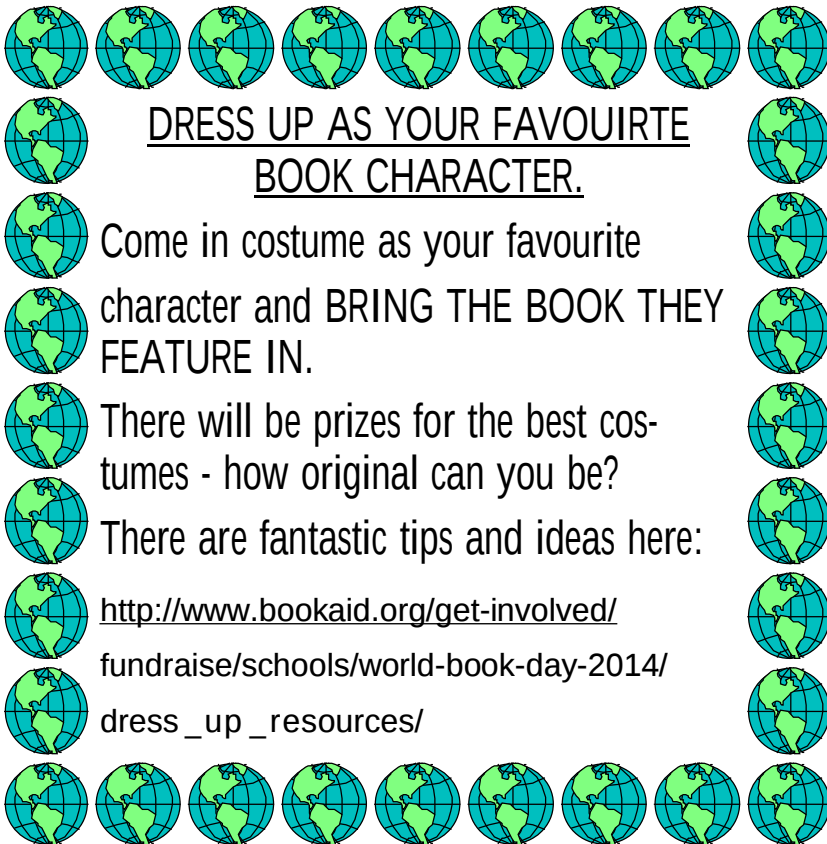

We are running a competition from now until World Book Day for the most extreme places reading has taken place. A display will be made in school and they will also be displayed on the website where possible.

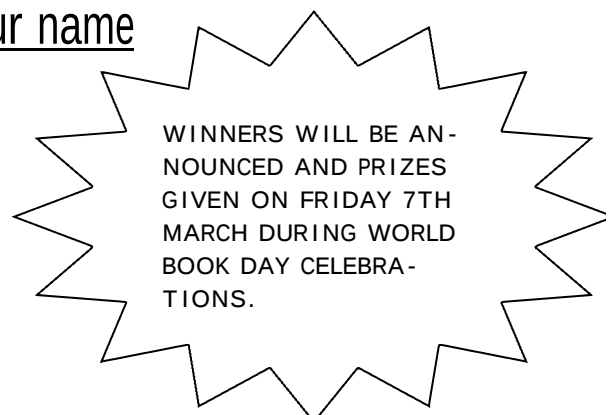
We are really looking forward to seeing who has such a passion for reading that they will do it anywhere and everywhere!
