Behaviour in School

At Castle Camps, we have high expectations for good behaviour throughout the school and at all times during the school day. Hopefully, the seating plan is a temporary arrangement that can be stopped after the half term break.

We ask for parents' to support us in reminding their child/children of appropriate behaviour in school to ensure break times are happy times for all. Staff and I will continue to celebrate good behaviour through praise, our House Point system, Values Assembly and new Gold Behaviour stickers.
