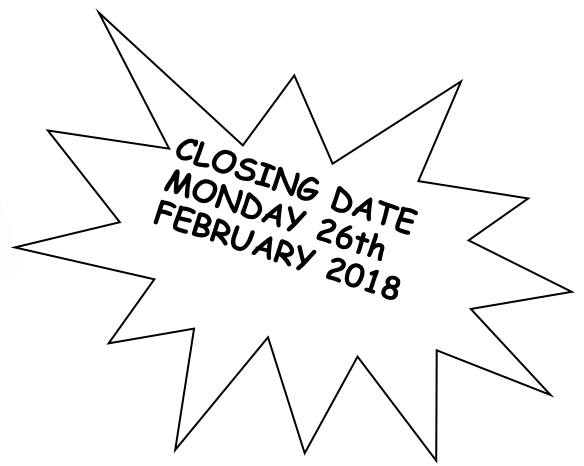
**READ SOMETHING NEW EVERY DAY FOR A MONTH!**

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We are running a competition from now until World Book Day for the most extreme places reading has taken place. A display will be made in school and they will also be displayed on the website where possible.

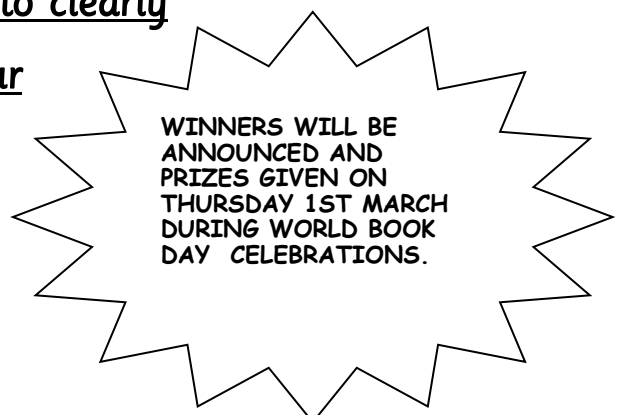
