Dear Parents/Carers,

It will be a challenging and busy but enjoyable term, especially for Year 6 who will be preparing to close their primary school chapter and begin their next adventure.

Just a reminder about some of the expectations and routines in Deer Class.

Homework: The children will continue to have an Arithmetic Challenge, a Spelling Challenge and Topic/Science/PSHE based homework. The Maths will be completed in the Maths homework books. The spelling will be sent home in their spelling books and the rest will be uploaded onto Google Classroom to be completed over the course of the term.

Children should also continue to practise their times tables as these will be tested weekly in school. Additionally, children should be reading for at least 20 minutes daily.

PE: Your child will need a named PE kit suitable for indoor and outdoor use which must be in school on Mondays ready for the week ahead.

Reading: Reading with your child is invaluable. I urge you to spend 20 minutes every day sharing and discussing books.

Zip Wallet: Children will have a zip wallet to bring their belongings. Please avoid bringing other bags as the cloakroom area is very cramped and extra bags take up a lot of space.
