




Our model for Spiritual Development	
 <p>Windows – Learning about life</p> <p><i>Look outwards. Learn.</i></p>	<p>We give children opportunities to become <i>aware</i> of the world in new ways; to wonder about life's 'Wows' (things that are amazing and unexplainable as to why they evoke such a response) and 'Ows' (things that upset us and cause us to be uncertain). In this, our children are learning <i>about life in all its fullness</i>.</p>
 <p>Mirrors – Learning from life</p> <p><i>Look inwards. Reflect. Ask questions.</i></p>	<p>We give children opportunities to reflect on their experiences; to meditate and reflect on life's big questions and to consider some possible answers. In this, they are learning <i>from</i> life by exploring their own insights and perspectives and those of others.</p>
 <p>Doors – Learning to live life</p> <p><i>Respond. Step out. Live our values.</i></p>	<p>We give children the opportunity to respond to all of this; to do something creative as a means of expressing, applying and further developing their thoughts and convictions. In this, they are learning to live by putting into action what they are coming to believe and value.</p>
