


## What my child will be studying in the Summer Term 2025 in Deer Class

<b>Values</b>  We will continue to promote the ‘Values’ of the school.  <b>Collective Worship</b>  We will be looking at our values and considering how we show and share these, mindfulness and different bible stories.		<b>Homework</b>  We will be setting a spelling, a maths and topic/science based homework. These will be uploaded (or handed out in spelling/maths homework books) on a Friday, to be completed and handed in the following Thursday. Please also ensure your child is practising their times tables. Additionally, children should be reading for at least 20 minutes daily.	
<b>English:</b>  We will begin our creative writing with a story inspired by the short animation ‘Paperman’. Our other fiction units will provide children the opportunity to show a secure grasp of a wide range of literary devices.  Our Non Fiction writing will include recounts as well as applying Instructional and Explanation writing skills within a range of subjects.  Grammar, spellings and handwriting will continue to be taught and monitored weekly in class.			<b>Maths:</b>  We will be learning new methods in maths this term as well as consolidation of previous knowledge and understanding. We will also be applying our knowledge to other areas of the curriculum, and linking to real life situations.
<b>PSHE &amp; RE:</b> This term in PSHE, we will be looking at Relationships and SRE (taught by Mrs Wright – PSHE Lead)  In RE we will be learning about Humanism.			<b>History &amp; Geography:</b> Our topic this term will be about Trade and Economics with a specific focus on El Salvador as a country in the wider world. We will be focusing our learning on understanding imports and exports, Fair Trade and how countries rely on exported goods.
<b>PE:</b>  During Tuesday’s PE session, we will be working on fitness, dance and gymnastics. PE on Fridays with Mr Goddard will be Athletics and Cricket. In Summer 2 we will also teach swimming.			<b>Science:</b>  In the first half term, we will be studying Forces. In the second half term, our Scientist Study will be on Steven Hawking.
		<b>French:</b> - Miss O’Connor will be teaching the children about weather and music.  <b>Music:</b> - We will be learning to play the Ukulele and preparing for the leaver’s service.  <b>Computing:</b> - We will be building our programming skills and applying them to real life situations.	<b>Art and Design and Technology:</b>  In DT, the children will be using Textiles skills to create a soft toy based on their own design. In Art, the children will be refining their weaving skills to create a basket similar in style to those produced for export in El Salvador.
