Class Information...

All new parents should have now received an activation email for your Tapestry account, please let us know if you have not received this.

Weekly information about the class learning will be added to Tapestry Memo every Thursday.

Please check your Tapestry account regularly as this is our main form of communication, including messages and homework too.



Things to bring to school...

Please remember to make sure the following items are in school everyday:

- A water bottle (only water - no squash or flavoured water please).
- PE kit - containing a change of underwear in case of accidents.
- Named raincoat and wellies (these can be left on their peg all term).
- School book bag for reading books, and homework for Reception children (*further details to come*).
- Send in your school dinner choice slip or bring a packed lunch.
- Sunhat (weather dependent)

PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL ITEMS AND CLOTHES ARE CLEARLY LABELLED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME.

PE

Our PE days are Wednesdays, and Monday mornings for Mini-movers with Kate, which will start at the end of September. I will send a memo about this nearer the time. Please make sure PE kit is in school for Wednesday's for now.

We will cover a range of physical activities including gymnastics, dance and games. Please ensure your child has a full set of P.E. clothes in school - shorts, t-shirt, pumps or trainers and outdoor jumper and jogging bottoms.

Please could you include spare socks and underwear in the bag.



Toys from home....

Just a reminder for the new term.. please could you refrain from allowing your child to bring any personal toys or items from home unless requested by school. Thank you.

Reading...

Sharing a story is an invaluable part of your child's development. Please try to read to, and with, your child as often as you can. This can be a range of books from home, school or your library.

All children will bring a school library book home shortly, Reception will also have reading books, all of which will be changed on a weekly basis. Please can Reception parents record the titles of the reading books, and write a brief comment in their child's communication book.



Tapestry and Home Learning...



We use online software called Tapestry to record children's observations and photos and send messages. This online platform is open to parents so that you can follow your child's learning at school and support this by following up activities at

home. You can share their achievements from home too by posting observations.

Phonics home learning will also be posted on this for Reception children each Friday.

Lunch Arrangements...

All children in Reception and KS1 are entitled to a **free school meal** everyday, funded by the Government. The menu is on a 3 week rotation with a daily choice of meals. Please read the menu with your child, help them to choose the meal they would like to order and complete the weekly form to hand to us.

School Dinners



Full-time nursery parents will need to pay for school meals using their school account, or send in a packed lunch.
